CORONAVIRUS INFO

We are trying to make the best show possible given the current COVID situation. As of 8/10, the state of WA is allowing shows like ours with mandatory restrictions.

All participants will be required to adhere to these main items (more details pg 2)

Cloth Masks mandatory indoors at all times – even when running.

Masks required outdoors when not socially distant.

No Crating allowed indoors

No spectators, visitors, family, friends allowed – only participants and crew Only allowed indoors while running or walking course Dedicated "flow" of people thru building. Dedicated entrance/exit doors.

A COVID waiver will be required when you arrive (for club, crew, facility)

A set of COVD questions and possibly a temp check will be done each morning

If you feel that you cannot adhere to these restrictions, are sick, have been exposed to COVID-19, or have other reasons not to be around crowds – please stay home!

Seattle Kennel Club Agility Trial 2021 Covid Information

We are working to be compliance with AKC, CDC, State and County Health guidelines. All guidelines may change as we get closer to the event time.

Masks – Cloth masks are required in all indoor areas in WA state. That includes while running your dog. This is a state mandate and one we are required to follow. The exits from the building are close to the rings and we will try and provide an outside the doors for you to remove your masks.

Food - The club will not be offering any food. We will be offering water from bottles, but you will be given them from someone with PPE. There will be no evening pot lucks and unfortunately, no MACH/PACH cakes. Please plan accordingly.

Crating - There will be no crating in the stalls. We are required to minimize the number of people in the building and insure those that are in the building are distanced. Crating out of your vehicle will be encouraged. You are also welcome to bring shade tents and there will be a designated location (to be determined). Parking spots close to the entrance and exit doors will be reserved for those crating from vehicles. The "in" doors and "out" doors will be clearly marked and left open. Please honor those door signs.

Washing, disinfectants, PPE – Hand washing is critical. We are working to expand those facilities. Hand sanitizer and other limited PPE will be available from the club, but please plan on bring your own.

Bathrooms - Disinfecting spray will be in the porta-potties and restrooms for seats and door handles. It will be your responsibility to sanitize upon entering and leaving these locations.

Trial Specific Modifications:

Gate Check-in/Steward - One person will be doing check-in and will receive worker coupons. Class run order copies will be made for handlers by class, so people don't have to keep looking at the board. Daily run orders will also be posted in many locations. This will force us to limit moving of dogs after running order is printed and posted. This may mean that it may be necessary that we wait for people with multiple dogs.

Briefings by Judge and Trial Chair – We will have limited briefings. We must have very few people in the building at any given time. We will do our best to communicate (postings, website, texting, etc) so please bear with us.

Handlers waiting for their turn - Six-foot markings (don't know how we are going to do that yet) will be created and Handlers/dogs will be expected to play musical markings until their turn in the ring. Then, they will proceed to the entry gate as instructed by the Gate Steward. **Handlers must wear masks whenever in the ring – including while running**.

Walk-Throughs - Walk-throughs will be managed by number of handlers in a height class and announced at the briefings. Open and Novice will not have by heights. Fast, T2B and Master will be split and may be individual heights depending on the number of handlers per heights. This will enable walk-throughs to be smaller. We must keep each ring to less than about 20 people at a time, so there may be many walkthrus.

NOTE: In order to minimize changes, We MAY use the same schedule/Walk-throughs for the whole weekend.

Workers - Masks and gloves should be worn for all positions while in the ring.

The Chief Ring Steward and/or Trial Chair will have the white boards set up outside near the entrance doors. You will be given a post-it to write your name on and post on these white boards. Please try and remember to remove your name if you are unable to perform the duties and after working to preserve making more post-its. You are welcome to make numerous post-its to help where ever

The scoring table, leash runner, and bar setters should disinfect the chairs upon completion of their class. You are welcome to disinfect before as well. There will be disinfectant at the scorer's table. The timer will be located at a different location than the scorer.

Results/Stickers/Ribbons - Results will be posted on wall boards by class instead of in the binders. Stickers will be printed and precut, so you will only pick up your own. Ribbons will be laid out on the table. The results and ribbons MAY be on a table outside near the trial secretary area. Only take your own.

Waivers and COVID check-in:

Waiver – The SKC, R2Agility, and Fun Fur Paws, their owners, operators, members, and volunteers are working very hard to make this event the most compliant event possible. However, activities like dog shows are potentially dangerous given the current COVID pandemic. A specific waiver will need to be signed holding the above entities harmless in the event somebody gets sick at the event. This is in addition to the waiver on the AKC entry form.

COVID Check-in – To help meet the WA state guidelines for this event, each participant will need to answer a brief set of questions and potentially have a non-contact temperature check. Are you feeling sick now? Have you been exposed to COVID recently? Have you received a positive COVID test in the last 14 days?

ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

"The SKC are accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 220, Paper entries: 440. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

- 1) include postage or be metered;
- 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required"

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and ribbons for first through fourth place in each height division in each class. Rosettes for new titles earned will be awarded.

Regular Classes First Place: Blue Second Place: Red Third Place: Yellow Fourth Place: White Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

MACH/PACH bars and Ribbons:

A MACH bar and ribbon will be awarded to all dogs that inform the trial secretary of the title possibility by closing. A "New Title" ribbon will be awarded to those recipients that have not previously informed the trial secretary. Help us make sure that we have enough fancy MACH awards available by telling us before closing so we can help you celebrate your big event!

Check your entry forms and confirmations:

Please be aware that AKC rules prohibit modification of an entry after the closing date/time. The ONLY allowed changes are for "move-ups" in class and those are required in writing by 6PM of the Monday before the trial. The trial secretary is not allowed to change jump heights, preferred vs. regular, or move down in classes after closing.

A preliminary email confirmation will be sent when the entry is received and processed. Make sure to check those confirmations closely and notify the trial secretary if you have corrections or changes before the closing date.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judges only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial who do not possess an official height card.

<u>OBSTACLES:</u> Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. <u>All Days</u> there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

<u>CLASSES OFFERED</u>: See the chart above for offered classes each day. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the "Dogs To Be Measured List". It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in."

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level
 entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level
 changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking
 in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, without the agreement attached are not acceptable.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Seattle Kennel Club assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, March 8th.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to robin@r2agilityonline.com. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the last class of each day.

REFUNDS: A complete refund will be given, for any reason, if received before the closing date and time. After closing, a refund of entry fees less \$5/run will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary by the start of the day. No refunds will be given for amounts less than \$10

RING and CRATING INFORMATION: At this time, there will be NO crating indoors except possibly for staff. Please plan on crating from your car or bring a popup to place outside (no mats).

<u>Food Information:</u> There are fast food locations and grocery stores in Mt. Vernon within a few miles of the show site. There will not be a general lunch available, so please plan accordingly.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
