One half of entry fee will be refunded for bitches in season provided that written notification is provided to the Trial Secretary prior to the show date.

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel club or that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

### Course Familiarization and Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes may walk the course without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The safety of the dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Aggressive dogs will not be allowed.

### Important Information for Exhibitors:

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after entries close. (Except for move-up provisions as specified below.)

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

*Entries which are incorrect, illegible, or incomplete will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor.*

#### Move-ups:

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted, in writing, to the Trial Secretary by 6:00 pm PST, Monday, January 26, 2015. E-mail move-ups are acceptable. Move-ups for dogs who complete titles on Saturday and wish to move up on Sunday must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than one-half hour after the completion of judging on Saturday.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.

Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of **AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable.**

E-mail entries will not be accepted. If you send an entry in Fed Ex or overnight (Express) mail **PLEASE CHECK the "NO SIGNATURE" box** – I am frequently not home and the post office is closed before I am off work.

We will be accepting entries on a "first received" basis. After the limit has been reached, we will maintain a waiting list until close of entries. Anyone withdrawing before close of entries will receive a full refund.

Entries received before the "official opening date & time" of Monday, September 1, 2014 will be returned, as per AKC regulations.

Conformation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, contact the trial secretary.

I will e-mail conformations after the opening date as the entries are entered in the computer. Final conformations will be sent by e-mail or snail mail as soon as I have completed the running order list. Please note: We will not be doing formal check-in at the show. Exhibitors should check in directly with the gate steward unless your dog needs to be measured. Armband labels will be in a notebook at a CHECK IN TABLE in ALPHABETICAL ORDER (Last Name). If you don't have a height card, your armband label will be with the trial secretary at the score table.

We will be accepting 50% online entries with [www.r2agilityonline.com](http://www.r2agilityonline.com) and 50% paper entries. (Entry limits are applicable for the first 48 hours after the trial opens.)

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the "Dogs to be measured" list. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check in. This will let us know in advance, how many dogs need to be measured so we can plan to allow the time for it.

## Directions to the show

### From North or South End:

Take I-5, I-405, SR-167 to Highway 18 eastbound. Exit onto Auburn-Black Diamond Rd. Eastbound. Turn RIGHT onto SE Green Valley Rd (just past Neely Mansion). Follow for about 7.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto 212<sup>th</sup> Way SE. Take First LEFT onto Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

### From Hwy 410 or WA 164 (Auburn—Enumclaw Hwy)

Turn LEFT onto 244<sup>th</sup> Ave. SE (approximately one mile out of Buckley) Go STRAIGHT at Stop Sign SE 416<sup>th</sup> St. Go STRAIGHT at Stop Sign SE 400<sup>th</sup> St. Turn LEFT at Sign onto SE 384<sup>th</sup> St. Turn RIGHT at Stop Sign 212<sup>th</sup> WAY SE. Turn RIGHT at ARGUS RANCH Sign (just before Bridge). Follow drive STRAIGHT ahead to Arena and signed parking.

### From SR-169 Southbound

Right onto Roberts Drive (in front of Coal Car) go approximately four miles. Left onto 218<sup>th</sup> Street. At bottom of the hill is a stop sign. Go straight across over cement bridge. Take first Left into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena.

Turn LEFT onto SE Green Valley Rd (in front of the Boondocks Nursery). Go about four Miles. Turn LEFT onto 212<sup>th</sup> Way SE. Go over the cement bridge. Take First LEFT into ARGUS RANCH and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time must include postage or be metered. Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

We will be accepting 50% mail-in entries and 50% online entries. Both mail-in and online entry limit of 50% is applicable for the first 48 hours after the trial opens.

A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.

**Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
