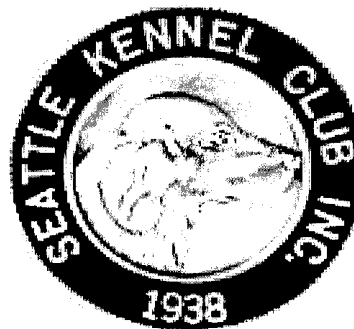

ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

“The Seattle Kennel Club is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 110 -- Paper entries: 220. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.”

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

- 1) include postage or be metered;
- 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) **Express mail must be designated “no signature required”**

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and ribbons for first through fourth place in each height division in each class. Rosettes for new titles earned will be awarded.

Regular Classes First Place: Blue Second Place: Red Third Place: Yellow Fourth Place: White Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

MACH/PACH bars and Ribbons:

A MACH bar and ribbon will be awarded to all dogs that inform the trial secretary of the title possibility by closing. A “New Title” ribbon will be awarded to those recipients that have not previously informed the trial secretary. Help us make sure that we have enough fancy MACH awards available by telling us before closing so we can help you celebrate your big event !

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judges only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial who do not possess an official height card.

8 inches for dogs **11 inches** and under at the withers
12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers
26 inches Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. *All Days* there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization**.

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Regular and JWW agility, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the **American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390**, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION: You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please indicate if you have a permanent or temporary height card on the entry form check box. You do **NOT** need to send in a copy with your entry. If you do not have a height card, you will need to be measured before you run.

RING and CRATING INFORMATION - There is crating space in the building adjacent to the ring.

Food Information - The concession stand is scheduled to be open all days of the trial.

Workers Information -We are using the white board for worker signup at this trial. All help is greatly appreciated !!!! We will be giving out tickets good toward for the worker raffle for entry to another SKC show.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, March 7th, 2016**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to r2agility@frontier.com. No phone move ups accepted. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

REFUNDS: A refund of the entry amount, less \$5/run, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary before the show.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

RV Parking –

RV parking is available in the north end lot (immediately north of the Seahawks stadium) for \$99.00 from 5 PM Friday through midnight Sunday for each vehicle up to 60 feet total length. Vehicles more than 60 feet total length will be charged an additional \$99.00. No reservation required. No hook-ups are available. Pay at booth at entrance to the parking lot.

Day Parking

Day parking is available in the adjoining parking garage (\$15.00) or in adjacent private and city-owned parking lots. The In/Out passes can be purchased from the parking attendants.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. We will NOT wait for exhibitors, except for pre-arranged changes due to conflict. **Entry Confirmations and approximate check-in times will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show**, contact the Trial Secretary. Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a stamped, self-addressed postcard with entry.

The show site will be available to exhibitors 3PM to 10PM Friday, March 11th, 2016. Doors are locked at 10PM. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging Sunday, March 13th, 2016.

Each entry will receive two (2) Identification/Admission wristbands per dog entered with their acknowledgement. Wristbands are good for each day that dog is entered. To gain admittance for each day into the show building, each person MUST wear their ID or pay admission. Absolutely NO EXCEPTIONS.

No baby strollers or wheeled child carriers allowed in the building.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Seattle Kennel Club and R2Agility** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ENTERED to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
