Driving Directions to Portland Expo Center

FROM I-5 NORTH OR SOUTHBOUND – Take exit 306B to get to the east side reserved/general parking entrance or take exit 307 Marine Dr. West to get to the Force Ave west side reserved parking entrance or to circle around the Expo to get to the exhibitor express entrance.

Dan Butcher – Saturday/Sunday

Measurements: It is YOUR responsibility to make sure you have a valid AKC height card. Please make sure to plan extra time BEFORE your run to get measured if your dog needs it.

A measuring official will be at the show, so all measurements will be “official”.

Class Schedule: **See the charts later in this document for each day.**
FAST is a combined course with a single course build and walkthrough for all levels (Exc/Opn/Nov). We will run FAST by jump height, so all levels will run together.

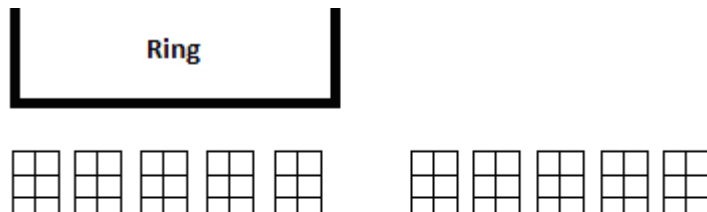
Walkthroughs: **All Classes – There will be a single, timed, walkthrough for each class.**

OK everybody THIS is really important stuff..... So is the section below about conflicts....

Crating:

NO X-Pens are allowed in the agility area. Please work together to share spaces. We don't have as many dogs this year, so can be a bit more flexible, but you are still expected to make room for each other. Having said that, please be aware of your non-crate stuff so there is enough room.

Potty Areas:

As indicated in the premium, it is a benchable offense to allow your dog to relieve themselves in the landscaped areas on the Expo site. This also extends to the business park to the West of the site. There are potty areas around the facility with shavings, so please use those.

Veterinarian:

Their phone number is 503-255-8139. They are open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The driving directions from the show site are as follows: Head east on Marine Dr W toward N Pier 99 St. Turn right to merge onto I-5 S. Slight right onto U.S. 30 E (signs for I-84 E/The Dalles). Continue onto I-84 E. Take exit 7 for Halsey St. toward Gateway **District**. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for 99th Avenue and merge onto NE 99th Ave. Turn left onto E Burnside St. Turn right onto SE 122nd Ave. Turn left onto SE Stark St., and the destination will be on the right.

Move-ups:

The deadline for move-ups is Monday Jan. 13th, at 6PM. Move-ups must be received in writing or email by that deadline. Day-to-Day move-ups are being accepted for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday but must be received no later than ½ hour after the last class.

Setup:

The agility area is being prepared on Wednesday morning. We anticipate that the area will be available for setup after 3PM, but don't have a firm time yet.

If you setup early and we need to move your stuff, we will. We plan on being there early on Wednesday afternoon and will coordinate setup at that time. There are some spaces reserved for our chief workers that will be identified on Wednesday. Please coordinate with the workers on site to setup in the proper place.

Conflicts:

There are lots of activities this weekend and there will be many conflicts. We will try to run the conflicts either at the start or the end of each class. Be sure to coordinate with Mrs. Robin and the gate stewards if you have a conflict. Be sure to mark a 'C' by your name on the gate sheet so we know about the conflict.

- If you are running in another activity, you will likely have a conflict.
- If you are running more than one dog, you are likely conflicted.
- If you have a conflict – or think you might have a conflict, make sure to walk your course with an earlier group.
- If you miss all the walkthrus – you might have to run without one, so make sure to walk early if needed.
