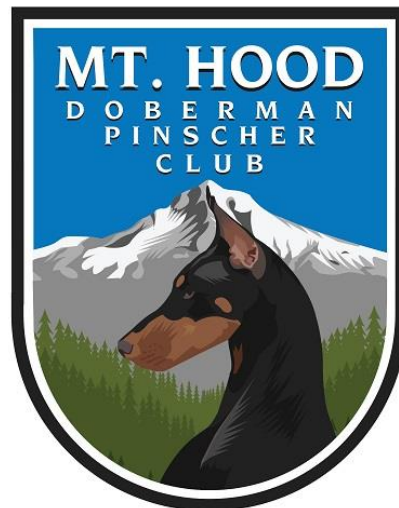

CORONAVIRUS INFO

**We are trying to make the best show possible given the current COVID situation. As of 8/10,
the state of WA is allowing shows like ours with mandatory restrictions.**

All participants will be required to adhere to these main items (more details pg 2)

**Cloth Masks mandatory indoors at all times – even when running.
Masks required outdoors when not socially distant.**

No Crating allowed indoors

**No spectators, visitors, family, friends allowed – only participants and crew
Only allowed indoors while running or walking course**

Dedicated "flow" of people thru building. Dedicated entrance/exit doors.

A COVID waiver will be required when you arrive (for club, crew, facility)

A set of COVID questions and possibly a temp check will be done each morning

**If you feel that you can not adhere to these restrictions, are sick, have been exposed to COVID-19,
or have other reasons not to be around crowds – please stay home!**

Mt. Hood Doberman Pinscher Club – COVID Agility Trial Info

We are working to be compliance with AKC, CDC, State and County Health guidelines. All guidelines may change as we get closer to the event time.

Masks – Cloth masks are required in all indoor areas in WA state. That includes while running your dog. This is a state mandate and one we are required to follow. The exits from the building are close to the rings and we will try and provide an outside the doors for you to remove your masks.

Food - The club will not be offering any food. There will be no evening pot lucks and unfortunately, no MACH/PACH cakes. Please plan accordingly. **Sweet-AIs WILL be onsite outside the building.**

Crating - There will be no crating in the building. We are required to minimize the number of people in the building, and insure those that are in the building are distanced. Crating out of your vehicle will be encouraged.

Washing, disinfectants, PPE – Hand washing is critical. Hand sanitizer and other limited PPE may be available from the club, but please plan on bring your own.

Bathrooms – Please distance yourselves in the bathrooms. Limit the number of people to 2 or fewer.

Trial Specific Modifications:

Gate Check-in/Steward - Class run order copies will be made for handlers by class so people don't have to keep looking at the board. Daily run orders will also be posted in many locations. This will force us to limit moving of dogs after running order is printed and posted. This may mean that it may be necessary that we wait for people with multiple dogs.

Briefings by Judge and Trial Chair – We will have limited briefings. We must have very few people in the building at any given time. We will do our best to communicate (postings, website, texting, etc) so please bear with us.

Handlers waiting for their turn - Six foot markings (don't know how we are going to do that yet) will be created and Handlers/dogs will be expected to play musical markings until their turn in the ring. Then, they will proceed to the entry gate as instructed by the Gate Steward. **Handlers must wear masks whenever in the ring – including while running.**

Walk-Throughs - Walk-throughs will be managed by number of handlers in a height class and announced at the briefings. Open and Novice will not have by heights. Fast, T2B and Master will be split and may be individual heights depending on the number of handlers per heights. This will enable walk-throughs to be smaller. We must keep each ring to less than about 20 people at a time, so there may be many walkthrus.

Workers - Masks and gloves should be worn for all positions while in the ring.

The Chief Ring Steward and/or Trial Chair will have the white boards set up outside near the entrance doors

The scoring table, leash runner, and bar setters should disinfect the chairs upon completion of their class. You are welcome to disinfect before as well. There will be disinfectant at the scorer's table. The timer will be located at a different location than the scorer.

Results/Stickers/Ribbons - Results will be posted on wall boards by class instead of in the binders. Stickers will be printed and pre-cut so you will only pick up your own. Ribbons will be laid out on the table. The results and ribbons MAY be on a table outside near the trial secretary area. Only take your own.

Waivers and COVID checkin:

Waiver – The MHDPC and R2Agility their operators, members, and volunteers are working very hard to make this event the most compliant event possible. However, activities like dog shows are potentially dangerous given the current COVID pandemic. A specific waiver may need to be signed holding the above entities harmless in the event somebody gets sick at the event. This is in addition to the waiver on the AKC entry form.

COVID Checkin – To help meet the WA state guidelines for this event, each participant will need to answer a brief set of questions and potentially have a non-contact temperature check. Are you feeling sick now? Have you been exposed to COVID recently? Have you received a positive COVID test in the last 14 days?

ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

"MHDPC is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 250 runs Paper entries: 450 runs. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

- 1) include postage or be metered;
- 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) **Express mail must be designated "no signature required"**

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular Classes First Place: Blue **Second Place:** Red **Third Place:** Yellow **Fourth Place:** White **Qualifying Score:** Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

A MACH Ribbon and MACH Bar will be given for any new MACH dog! Let us know if you are close.

All Breed High in Trial – from Exc/Mas Jww and Std classes

Custom embroidered folding chairs will be given out for High in Trial. The highest combined YPS from two clean rounds, for both small (Regular 8", 12" & 16", Preferred 4,8,12) and large (Regular 20", 24" & 24C", Preferred 16, 20) dogs will win.

High Scoring Dobermans

The highest scoring Exc/Mas Doberman in the STD class and JWW class on Saturday will be awarded a prize of approx. \$35 in value.

High in Group – open to all levels

A Rosette will be offered to the highest scoring dog in each Group Saturday, which will be awarded during Sunday's Exc. Std Class briefing. Scoring is highest combined YPS. The seven traditional AKC groups and a "non-group" including All American, AA, FSS, and misc.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judges only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial who do not possess an official height card.

8 inches for dogs **11 inches** and under at the withers
12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers
24 Choice Only for dogs 22" and under at owners discretion

4" Preferred class
8" Preferred class
12" Preferred class
16" Preferred class
20" Preferred class

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. *All Days* there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

CLASSES OFFERED: See the chart above for offered classes per day. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the **American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390**, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION: You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please indicate on the entry form if you have a height card (perm or temp), or need to be measured.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Mt. Hood Doberman Pinscher Club** assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, Sept 28, 2020.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to robin@r2agilityonline.com. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

REFUNDS: 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a **written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date.** After closing, refunds will be given, **if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial,** less all - \$8/run, for injured/ill handlers, or injured/ill dogs, or less \$5/run for bitches in season. MHDPC reserves the right to require certification of said injury or illness from a veterinarian or doctor prior to refund being issued. **No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial.** No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not allowed in the Agility Trial area.

RING and CRATING INFORMATION

There is an abundance of crating space around the rings on all sides, on concrete. There is no heating in the building, and portable propane heaters are not allowed in the building.

Volunteer Information – we need your help!

A trial is only successful with the generous help of volunteers. Please let us know if you are willing to help us make this trial a success by volunteering for any number of jobs we need to fill. Everyone who works will receive a coupon for the worker raffle.

Food

Sweet AIs is scheduled to be onsite, outside the building. Please do not congregate inside the building to eat so we can comply with the occupancy limits from the state.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
