From I-5 take Exit 9 (in Washington) and go west on 179<sup>th</sup> Ave for ½ mile. Turn left onto 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave, then left again at Gate 7. Expo and equestrian building is on the right at the end of the road

**Class Schedule:** See charts below: Start 9:00 AM Friday and 8:30 AM on weekend

**Measurements:** A measuring official(s) are scheduled to be on site. Check with the score table.

**Walkthroughs:** There will be split walkthroughs for the Exc Std and Jww classes.

**Vet on call:** Columbia River Vet Specialists, 6607 NE 84<sup>th</sup> Street, Vancouver, WA 98665 (just south of Costco). 360-694-3007.

**Moveups:** The deadline for moveups is Monday Sept 28 at 6PM. Moveups must be received in writing or email by that deadline. Day-to-Day moveups are accepted for Saturday & Sunday and must be received by ½ hour after the trial ends each day.

**Conflicts:** We want to make sure that everybody gets their walkthroughs and runs. If you have a conflict, please work with your gate steward or the trial secretary to move your dogs or mark as a conflict.

**Setup/crating:** **There is NO general crating allowed in the building. Due to the COVID limits on number of participants in the building at a time, we need the capacity to handle simultaneous walkthroughs.**

**The livestock stalls north of the arena will be open for crating. We are also working with the fairgrounds to have grass areas available for canopies. If you have a canopy, please don't use mats on the grass.**

**Workers:** Even given all the new “rules” and capacity limits, we STILL need your help putting on the show. If you can help out for a class – or a day – let us know. We'll have a chief worker person coordinating thing and likely have the white boards setup like usual. We're expecting a raffle !!! THANKS!

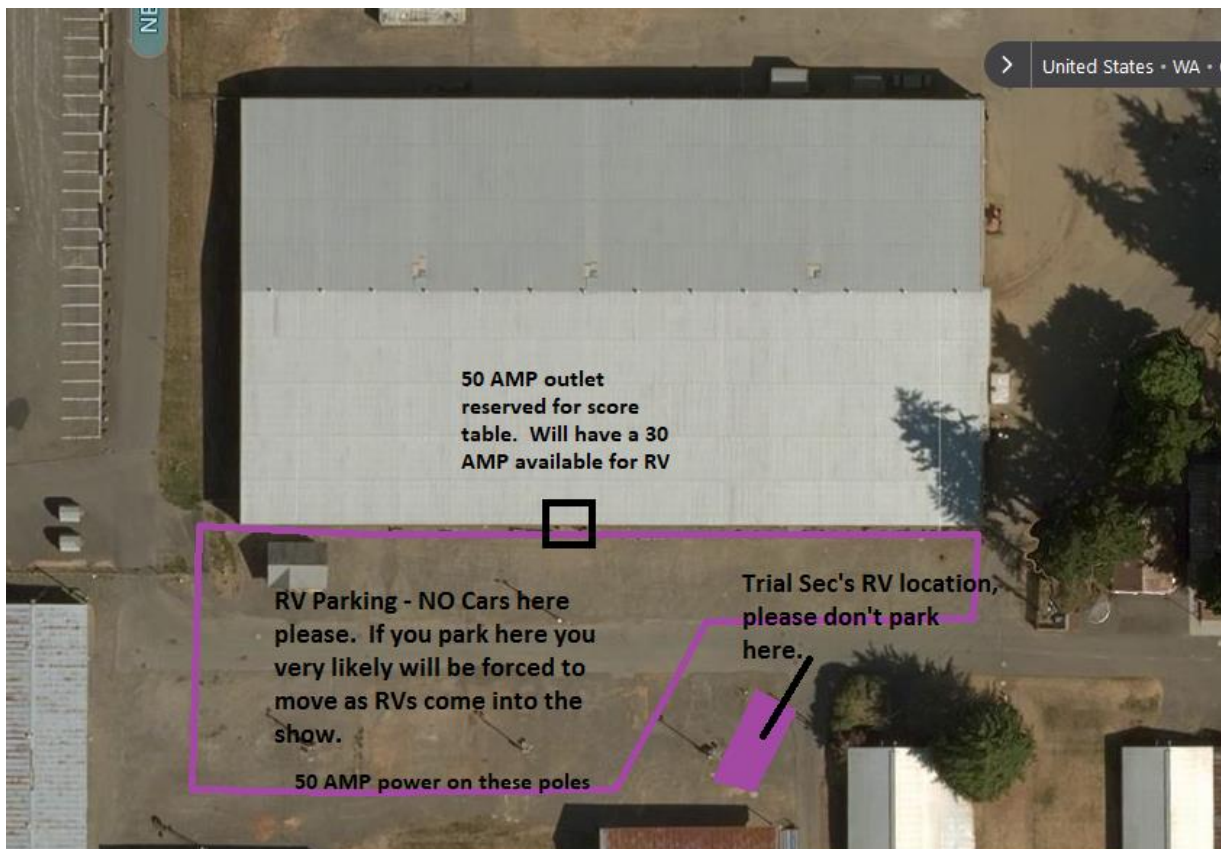
**Clean Up:** Please clean up after your dogs. We want to keep using this site in the future and need your help to keep it clean ☺

**Food:** Due to COVID, there will not be any food provided at the show. Please don't bring MACH cakes to share – but Congrats if you get one !. At this time, the onsite food vendor is NOT scheduled to be there either so please plan accordingly.

**Building Access:** We have to limit the number of people in the building at any time to 50 + staff. If you need to use the bathroom, check the worker board, check status, etc, please feel free to do so but limit your time as much as possible. We'll have several teams lined up to run and are trying to limit walkthroughs to reduce the number of people inside.

**Camping:** Camping is on the south side of the arena building against the building or across the road on the gravel area. You may arrive for camping on Thursday. Some spaces are reserved – if you arrive before 5PM on Thursday you may be asked to move. **There is NO camping on the north side of the arena.**

The facility has put in 6 new 50-AMP power in the RV area south of the building across the road. If your rig can't use 50 AMP, please consider leaving those outlets for the larger units.



**Car Parking:** Parking is in any marked spot around the building but NOT in the RV areas. Do not block any arena entrances or access roads.

The area south of the arena is primarily for RVs. There WILL be RVs coming in on Friday and Saturday. If there are cars parked in those power spots, they WILL have to move. We will hold the show if needed to insure that those spots are available for the RVs.

# COVID Specific Information

## Masks must be worn at all times in the building

**COVID Check-in:** All persons at the event MUST check in each day with the Covid desk. You will be asked a set of COVID related questions (are you sick, have you been exposed, etc). You may also have your temp checked with a non-contact thermometer. After check-in you will be given a sticker.

You will not be allowed in the building without a sticker.

**Access Inside:** To comply with the State's COVID rules, we are restricting access inside the building. We will be limiting running orders as needed to keep under the capacity limits.

You may have someone come in and video your runs or otherwise help you during your run.

The state is prohibiting vendors, guests, and spectators at these events.

**Building Flow:** We are attempting to limit contact inside the building between participants. To do that, we are going to set up a "flow" of people entering and exiting the building for their runs. Basically, we are setting up a door to enter the building for each ring, and a door to exit. We will mark the paths accordingly.

We will have flow areas marked and probably have the two rings separated with a fence. Please help us keep people moving so we reduce the numbers inside at any one time.

**Course Maps:** We will not be providing general paper copies of course maps. Maps will be made available on our website after 6PM the previous night. [www.r2agility.net](http://www.r2agility.net) If you need a paper copy, please print one at home.

**Leashes:** We are planning on a leash runner, but AKC rules now allow you to put your leash in your pocket, or tie around your waist while you run. This allows only YOU to handle your leash. NOTE: if your dog grabs/tugs on the leash while running, the judge will signal an 'E'. ☹️

**Gate Check-in:** We will have a normal gate steward with a paper gate sheet, but will also be using a new electronic gate checking and monitoring system available by any internet enabled phone with a web browser. The URL for the gate checking, conflicts, scores, maps, and results is [www.r2agility.net](http://www.r2agility.net). The gate stewards will have tablets to indicate dogs that have run. Exhibitors will be able to remotely check in or mark themselves absent safely from outside the building.

**Results:** Results will be posted outside the building and will be available on the same web page as the running order. We will also post results to the website as they are generated throughout the day so you can get them remotely.

**COVID Waiver:** **Due to the nature of our current COVID environment, a waiver will be required to be signed by all persons at the facility. Those with minors, please sign a waiver for your child.**

While we are doing all that we can to provide the best environment possible to hold agility events at Clark County, we understand that COVID is an infectious disease and outside our control. The following waiver is designed to hold the club, secretary, fairgrounds, and trial staff harmless for events related to the COVID pandemic.

Please read the attached waiver, sign, and bring with you to the show. You can give the waiver to the person handling the COVID check-in procedure.

On my behalf, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the facility, event giving club, their members, directors, governors, agents, event secretary, any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties., and any AKC approved judge, of and from the claims, including all liabilities, claims actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the aforementioned parties, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in this agility event.

By signing this waiver, I agree to the following:

*I attest to the best of my knowledge that I DO NOT have COVID-19 at the time of attending the above referenced dog agility trial. I also attest that I have not knowingly been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID-19 within the past 21 days. I agree that I will follow all posted protocols, city, county, and state rules and requirements to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading the virus during my attendance at this event.*
