ENTRY INFORMATION: One entry form per dog may be used for all days, except for mixed entries see page 5.

\$12.00 2nd, 3rd, 4th, & 5th regular entry, same dog same day (includes \$3 AKC recording fee)

Dogs eligible to enter: This Trial is open to all dogs 15 months or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained ILP/PAL numbers or listed in the AKC Canine Partners program or approved FSS breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. AKC Canine Partners must provide their listing number on the entry blank and designate breed as "All American".

Catalog: \$15.00 Please pre-order catalogs using check box on entry form. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the show.

Closing Date: 6:00 PM Friday Oct. 2nd, 2020

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and ribbons for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular Classes First Place: Blue **Second Place:** Red **Third Place:** Yellow **Fourth Place:** White **Qualifying Score:** Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

A MACH / PAX / PACH Ribbon and Jump Bar will be given for any new MACH / PAX / PACH dog! Please let me know before the trial if you are close.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, Oct. 5th, 2020.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to arrmet@aol.com. No phone move-ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

The regulations now allow exhibitors who have entered a class for which they or their dog is not eligible, to change their entry to a class for which they are eligible. The request for such a change must be in writing and must be submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. **THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT MOVEUPS CAN BE DONE AT THE LAST MINUTE!** It does mean that if you have previously moved up and then learn your dog has not met the requirements for moving up, you may move back to the correct class, or if you entered Novice A and dog or handler is not eligible, you may move to Novice B. If you have questions. **DON'T GUESS – PLEASE ASK!** arrmet@aol.com

REFUNDS: A refund of entry fees will be given for any bitch that comes into season after the close of entries, provided that the trial secretary is notified before the commencement of judging each day. Except for the above, there shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

Bitches in season are not allowed in the Agility Trial area.

JUDGE SCHEDULE: Two rings 100'x100' Outdoors on grass

Friday rings will alternate. Saturday, Sunday 2 rings will run concurrently.

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Standard, Jumpers, (Fri, Sat, Sun) and FAST (Sat, Sun), including the Preferred Classes will be offered. T2B will be offered Friday, & Sunday. Premier Standard & JWW will be offered Saturday. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

JUDGING: Starts no earlier than 8:30 AM on Friday, and 8:00AM on both Saturday and Sunday. Judge's briefing and course walk-through will take place prior to those times. **FAST courses will be nested, with one walk-through for Excellent/Masters, Open & Novice together. They may also be judged together.**

Anticipated Order of Classes (any changes will be published in the Judging Program)

Friday: Ring 1 – T2B, Standard (Exc/Master, Open, Novice) Alternate with Ring 2
Ring 2 – JWW (Exc/Master, Open, Novice)

Saturday: Ring 1 – Standard (Premier, Exc/Mas, Open, Novice)
Ring 2 – FAST (Exc/Mas, Open/Novice) JWW (Novice, Open, Exc/Mas, Premier)

Sunday: Ring 1 – T2B, Standard (Exc/Mas, Open, Novice)
Ring 2 - FAST (Open/Novice, Exc/Mas) JWW (Novice, Open, Exc/Mas)

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: There is a new section at top of entry form to designate if your dog has a valid height card or if it needs to be measured. Neither Danielle LaGrave nor Susan Leitner are VMO (Volunteer Measuring Officials), so due to COVID-19 guidelines, dogs will not need to be measured at these trials. Height divisions are as follows:

24C"	n/a	Dogs who measure into 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions May opt to enter the 24-choice height division at their owner's discretion. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may NOT enter 24-choice.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

RING and CRATING INFORMATION:

There is ample space for crating around the rings. There is very limited shade, so plan accordingly.

VOLUNTEERS

We are using the white board signup at the trial for volunteers. If you can help out for a class, please sign up in the morning or check with the chief ring steward. Thank you to everybody that helps out!!! We are working on COVID-19 lunch plans.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms, or **without the agreement attached, are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Wenatchee Kennel Club** assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

FOOD INFORMATION

There are fast food locations and grocery stores in Wenatchee within a few blocks of the show site.

AKC recommends no potlucks. More information when entries close.

From East Hwy 97 and 2: Exit the Highway at Euclid Ave (follow State Park Signs). Turn left at the exit onto Euclid Ave. Follow it to Olds Station Rd and to the state park signs and entrance

CDC/COVID-19 WAIVER AND GUIDELINES

All CDC, State and County guidelines related to Covid-19 will be closely followed. We are working hard to make sure all past practices are modified to adhere to those guidelines. Your health and safety is of utmost importance Guidelines will be included with the Final Confirmation letter which will be available five days before the event. Per AKC modified rules relating to COVID-19, the closing date has been changed to October 2, 2020. This is seven days before the event instead of fourteen days. Checks for entry fees will be held until October 2, 2020. If the event cannot be held, checks will be shredded. Any vouchers/certificates included with entries will be returned. If we cannot hold the event after entry fee checks have been deposited, then refunds will be sent once all funds have cleared the bank. R2agilityonline.com Entries will be refunded after the R2agility check has been received, deposited and cleared the club bank account.

PARKING & ACCOMODATIONS

NOTE: There are several events taking place in Wenatchee on this weekend, so make lodging arrangements early!

PARKING: A Discover Pass is required to park at Confluence State Park. Passes cost \$10 for one day or \$30 for an Annual Pass, which is valid at all Washington State Parks for 12 months from date of purchase. Passes are available at the Park entrance during business hours and from State Park offices.

CAMPING: Camping may be accommodated at two locations. RV (dry) camping is available adjacent the group parking area near the rings at a cost of \$25 per night (parks may alter cost Oct 1st). Trial Staff will collect these fees. The camping fee covers the daily Discover Pass requirement. Camping is also available at designated Park campsites, some of which have hookups.

NEW INFORMATION: Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights (in different classes) within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. (EXAMPLE: if you are entering a dog in some Regular classes and some Preferred classes submit one entry form for the Regular classes, and another entry form for the Preferred classes).

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form: the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring.
 - > Toys must be non-audible
 - > Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - > Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of one obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
