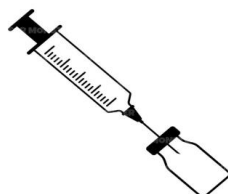

The Mt. Bachelor Kennel Club is doing everything possible to ensure your time at the show is fun and enjoyable. But, as you know, state/local mandates and policies are constantly changing. Therefore, the following MBKC guidelines are presently in place:

- ❖ You will be screened at the front gate or when you drive your RV in to park.
 - Liability Waiver/Exhibitor Responsibility: By entering this show, you and any person attending the show as a result of your entry, voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and agrees to comply with any Oregon State and/or Deschutes County Fair & Expo Center Requirements, Rules, and/or Guidelines.
 - Vaccinated exhibitors: Things change, so please **BE PREPARED** to provide proof of vaccination (copy of certificate, iPhone photo, Dr's notice, etc.). We're hoping you won't need to, but
 - Non-Vaccinated exhibitors: At this time, **MASK** and **SOCIAL DISTANCING** is adequate for Deschutes County Fair & Expo outside requirements. Mask for inside buildings or signed areas.
- ❖ Please adhere to all signs and posters which require everyone to wear a mask. That may be a building, restroom, or location or activity yet to be determined.
- ❖ Conformation Rings: ALL conformation exhibitors will be masked BEFORE they enter the show ring. This will be out of courtesy for the judge and ring steward who will be in contact with over 150+ different exhibitors throughout the day; as well as your fellow exhibitors.
- ❖ Be respectful of those wearing a mask - for whatever their reason. They just might be a vaccinated exhibitor whose comfort factor requires it. Or they may not be able to be vaccinated for a medical reason.

Exhibitor & COVID Agreement, Rules and Guidelines

BY SIGNING/SUBMITTING YOUR ENTRY FORM, YOU AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

1. By entering this show, you and any persons attending the show as a result of your entry voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19; and agree to comply with the COVID Rules and Guidelines. Your entry confirms the following for attendance:

A. You will attend the show only if you can voluntarily attest, to the best of your knowledge, that you (1) do not have COVID-19; and (2) have not been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID-19 within the past 14 days. You further attest that you are not currently displaying or feeling symptoms of COVID-19 (including, but not limited to, coughing, sneezing, elevated temperature, or any other symptom(s) that the United States Center for Disease Control has attributed to COVID-19).

B. You acknowledge that an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public or private place where people are present and further acknowledge that you attending these events entirely at your own risk and take full responsibility for your own health and safety, and the health and safety of any minor children or adults for whom you are responsible at these events.

C. You fully submit that all clubs, their members, their boards of directors, committee members, volunteers and/or workers at these events, Deschutes County Fairgrounds & Expo Center, and any other individuals involved with conducting and organizing these events shall not be held liable for any present or future COVID-19 exposure (including, but not limited to, any subsequent illness) incurred at any time by any person, in attendance or not in attendance at these events, during or after these events, and hereby waive all rights to bring any claims, charges, lawsuits or other legal actions against these clubs, their members, their boards of directors, committee members, volunteers and/or workers at these events, and any other individuals involved with conducting and organizing these events if you are exposed to or contract COVID-19.

2. General Rules. The Club Members, Fairgrounds Staff, and Parking crew are all working hard to put on the best event we can during these challenging times. To get approval for our event we had to agree to make changes for this year's shows. We expect all participants to comply with the Covid procedures. Disrespect of members and officials will not be tolerated.

A. A mask will be worn inside the show ring unless directly told by the judge that you may remove it.

B. Whether you are vaccinated or not, a mask will be worn in marked areas and buildings. Also, respect the wishes of those who choose to wear a mask at all times.

C. Your grooming equipment can be unloaded behind the grooming building, but you must then move your vehicle to the public parking area outside the fence. Ten minutes maximum unloading time. Masks will be worn in the grooming building.

D. Ringside crating will be kept to a minimum and at least 20 feet from the ring.

E. No ringside grooming.

F. There is a large grass area adjacent to the public parking north of the show entrance. Feel free to use it for day grooming, pop-ups, etc. All items must be removed at the end of each show day.

G. Carts will be available to transport you and your dog from your vehicle to the show.

H. As federal, state, and local COVID-19 mandates and rules may change, be flexible and prepare for such. Any changes will be posted at the front gate and where necessary. Please be polite and understanding to all show staff, as well as your fellow exhibitors.

USE OF RAMPS – ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: Boykin Spaniels, Lagotto Romagnolo, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendéen, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Whippets, and Miniature Bull Terriers.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp, or on a table: Mudi.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etnas, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Keeshonden, and Chow Chows. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor may withdraw their entry and receive a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (01/2021)

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

Winners, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed competition.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class -Vizslas & Belgian Malinois - Saturday Only: Each entry is allowed two to four get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
