## Running Order and Class Information July 10-11, 2021

**Argus Ranch Facility for Dogs - 35612 212th Way SE, Auburn, WA 98092**  
[www.argusranch.com](http://www.argusranch.com) - This trial will be held indoors at Argus Ranch.

### ***Driving Directions***

#### **From North or South End**

Take I-5, I-405, SR-167 to Highway 18 eastbound. Exit onto Auburn-Black Diamond Road eastbound. Turn RIGHT onto SE Green Valley Road (just past Neely Mansion). Follow for about 7.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto 212th Way SE  
Take First LEFT into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

#### **From SR 169**

Turn onto SE Green Valley Road (in front of the Boondocks Nursery). Go about four miles. Turn LEFT onto 212th Way SE. Go over the Cement Bridge. (Whitney Bridge) Take First LEFT into ARGUS RANCH and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

**Walkthroughs:** There will be split walkthroughs for **some classes**. See the charts for each day for the detail.

**Veterinarian:** 24-Hour Veterinarian: Sumner Vet Hospital, 16024 60<sup>th</sup> St. E, Sumner, WA 98390 253-863-2258  
**Directions:** From Argus Ranch – turn left onto 212<sup>th</sup> Way SE and drive about 2 miles to the top of the hill to the ‘T’. Take a left and immediate right to stay on 212<sup>th</sup> Way SE and continue south for 3.2 miles to WA-164<sup>th</sup>/SE 436<sup>th</sup> St. Turn left for 2.0 miles and turn right on 244<sup>th</sup> Ave SE. Drive for 2 more miles to WA-410 (Enumclaw Buckley Rd) and turn right. Drive for 10.8 miles to the 166<sup>th</sup> Ave Exit and turn right onto Sumner Tapps Hwy E. Drive north for .3 miles and take a left onto 60<sup>th</sup> St. E Drive for .4 miles and the hospital is on the left.

**Moveups:** The deadline for moveups is July 5 at 6PM. Moveups must be received in writing or email by that deadline. Day-to-Day moveups are being accepted for Saturday and Sunday.

**Setup and crating:** **There is NO general crating allowed in the building. Popup tents and crating is allowed along the South grass areas on the knoll (not on the field). If using a popup or crate on the grass, please do NOT use mats or leave items overnight.**

**RVs:** All RV camping must be arranged with Argus Ranch. See [argusranch.com](http://argusranch.com) for more info.

**Food:** Due to the required COVID restrictions by the state, we will NOT be providing any food, snacks or refreshments at the show. Please bring your own provisions ☺

**Workers:** you can help out for a class – or a day – let us know. We’ll have a chief worker person coordinating thing and likely have the white boards setup like usual. THANKS!

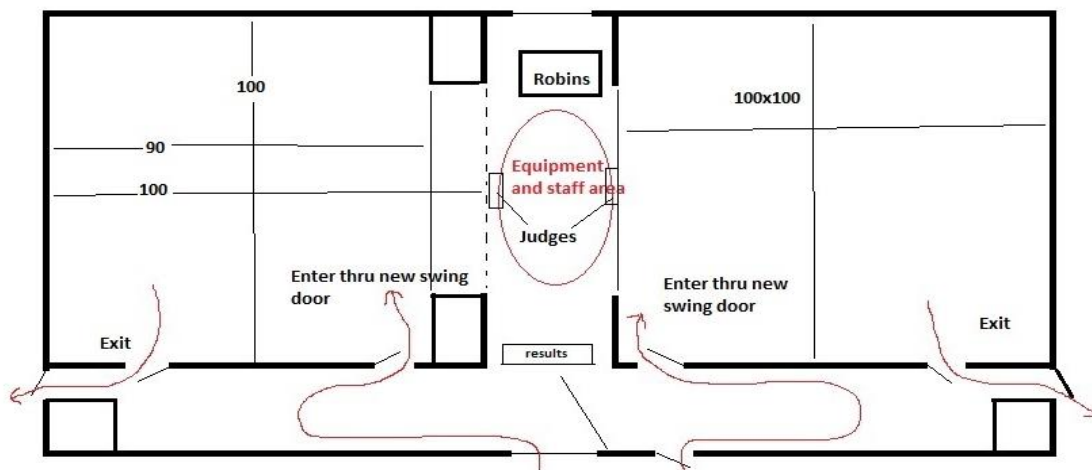
**Measuring:** A volunteer measuring official will be on site. Check with the score table for more info.

# COVID Information

**Masks:** The latest rules from Argus Ranch are that masks are NOT required outdoors or in the competition arena where there is good air flow. If you are non-vaccinated please consider a mask in crowded spaces and groups.

**COVID Check-in:** There is no daily COVID check-in at this show. You will need to either bring a paper copy of the Argus Ranch waiver or sign one electronically per Argus Ranch rules.

**Building Flow:** This diagram shows how the rings are laid out. Most of the doors on the East side of the building will be open. The center aisle between the rings is for equipment, staff and judges. Ribbons and results will be on tables near the aisle entrance.



**Course Maps:** We will not be providing general paper copies of course maps. Maps will be made available on our website sometime after 6PM the previous night. If you need a paper copy, please print one at home.

**Results:** Results will be posted outside the building and will be available on the same web page as the running order. We will also have a TV monitor with the latest scores from each ring as they are entered into the computer.

**COVID Waiver:** **Argus Ranch is requiring that a waiver be signed by all persons at the facility. Those with minors, please sign a waiver for your child.**

Please read the attached waiver, sign, and bring with you to the show. You can give the waiver to the person handling the COVID check-in procedure.

Before the show, all listed handlers will receive a web link to allow for electronic signing of the Argus waiver. That web page also allows you to “invite” others (spouses, kids, etc) to electronically sign. Simply add their name and email address and click the button. They will receive a unique email link to follow and sign the form.

Argus Ranch may have additional restrictions or rules. Please see [www.argusranch.com](http://www.argusranch.com) for additional info.

**Gate Check-in:** We will have a normal gate steward with a paper gate sheet and will also be using an electronic gate checking and monitoring system available by any internet or wifi enabled device with a web browser.

The new system allows you to check-in, mark conflict or absent, see progress, and live scores as they are entered into the computer. Please check the status to make sure your runs are correct.

Maps will also be available on the same page (internet or local) sometime after 6PM.

Select one of the following:  R2Net (local router) – no password needed R2Gate (extended WiFi mesh) – pswd: r2agility1  Open a <b>browser</b> and go to 192.168.1.7  The local WiFi does NOT have an internet connection
Both r2agility.net and the local 192.168.1.7 web addresses will allow you to check-in, conflict or mark absent. As scores are added to the computer, the run results will also show up on the right hand side. This allows you to keep track of the progress of the rings.

The Puget Sound Doberman Pinscher Club, R2Agility, and Argus Ranch LLC have put in place some new protocols & guidelines/preventative measures to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 at the Argus Ranch facility; however, the agencies handling the agility trial CANNOT guarantee that you will not become exposed to or infected with COVID-19.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending this dog agility trial and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, or death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including but not limited to agents, event secretary, event-giving club, AKC, the facility and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and judge at the current event.

I voluntarily agree to assume all the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to myself (including but not limited to; personal injury, illness, permanent disability, or death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I may experience or incur in connection with my attendance or participation in the current event. On my behalf, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the facility, event giving club, their members, directors, governors, agents, event secretary, any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties., and any AKC approved judge, of and from the claims, including all liabilities, claims actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the aforementioned parties, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in this agility event.

By signing this waiver, I agree to the following:

*I attest to the best of my knowledge that I DO NOT have COVID-19 at the time of attending the above referenced dog agility trial. I also attest that I have not knowingly been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID-19 within the past 21 days. I agree that I will follow all posted protocols, city, county, and state rules and requirements to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading the virus during my attendance at this event.*

*I fully submit that the aforementioned entities related to this dog agility event are in no way liable for any present or future COVID-19 exposure incurred at any time by any person, whether in attendance or not, during or after my dog related activities at this event.*
