Hurricane Ridge Kennel Club: Trial Covid Information

Our goal is to provide a safe environment for all participants and workers while having a fun, successful show. We are working to be compliant with AKC, CDC, State and County Health guidelines. Current guidelines were issued on March 19, 2021 for Agricultural Events (including dog shows).

Any participant that cannot adhere to the guidelines, are ill or have been exposed to another with COVID-19 are asked to stay home.

More detailed, up-to-date information will be sent with the Final Confirmation.

General Info

Masks - Cloth masks are required at all times while on the show grounds. A determination regarding whether or not exhibitors will be able to show in the ring without a mask will be announced in the Final Confirmation letter.

Maintain social distancing while on show site.

No spectators, guests, vendors will be allowed within and between the two baseball fields. We will have a Show Photographer.

Food - The Club will not be offering any food. Please plan on bringing your own food and beverages

Crating / Chairs - There will be limited crating on the baseball fields - first come, first serve. Designated locations will be flagged and need to have a minimum 10' between canopies. No chairs around the ring will be allowed except for ring crew.,

PPE - Hand washing is critical. Hand sanitizer and limited PPE will be available from the Club, please plan on bringing your own.

Bathrooms - Disinfecting spray will be in the porta-potties and restrooms for seats and door handles. It will be your responsibility to sanitize upon entering and leaving these locations. There will be a hand washing station available.

Waivers and COVID check-in Waiver: HRKC and the City of Sequim, their owners, operators, members, and volunteers are working to make this event the most compliant event possible. However, activities like dog shows are potentially dangerous given the current COVID pandemic. A specific waiver will need to be signed holding the above entities harmless in the event somebody gets sick at the event. This is in addition to the waiver on the AKC entry form. We will send the waiver with the final confirmation.

COVID Check-in - WA state guidance for customers has changed. We are NOT anticipating having a daily COVID screening with temperature checks. Instead, a pre-show checklist may be included with the waiver to ask the general COVID questions. **We will have a check-in table to verify receipt of the waiver.**

ATTENTION: EXHIBITORS STAYING IN LOCAL HOTELS HOTEL POLICIES

We do not have a large quantity of hotel rooms in this area. Therefore, maintaining a good relationship with those that will accept dogs is CRITICAL to YOU, our exhibitors. To help ensure that we have hotels that will accept dogs in the future, the following policies are now in effect and will be strictly enforced. Violation of these policies may result in a HRKC/AKC Bench Hearing.

IF YOU PLAN TO STAY IN A HOTEL AND TAKE YOUR DOG INTO THE ROOM:

- Contact the Hotel DIRECTLY to make your reservation. Indicate you require a "dog room" - DO NOT use a third party reservation service.
- ABSOLUTELY NO BATHING OF DOGS is allowed in ANY of the guest rooms, guest room bathrooms or bathtubs
- Dogs MUST be on a leash in public areas of the hotel at all times.
- Dogs MUST be exercised in the designated dog area.
- You MUST pick up after your dog! DO NOT allow your dog to urinate on buildings, garbage cans, etc.
- NO DOGS are to be left UNATTENDED in guest rooms at ANY TIME!
- No dogs are allowed IN or ON beds.
- Dogs that are excessively barking must be removed from the premises in respect for the other guests in the hotel.
- Do NOT take dogs into non-dog- allotted rooms. This creates problems for persons with allergies and requires special post-dog cleaning.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraphy entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry Fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The Hurricane Ridge Kennel Club and City of Sequim, assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up areas.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sports, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

ONLINE VS PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

HRKC is accepting online entries through R2AgilityOnline system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries is designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: 50% online and 50% paper entries. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of 48-hour time period, the Club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Paper entries received with 24 hrs. of opening date & time must include postage or be metered. Must be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender. **Express mail must be designated "no signature required".**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:

The trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Check your entry forms and confirmations.

Please be aware that AKC rules prohibit modification of an entry after the closing date/time. The ONLY allowed changes are for "move-ups" in class and those are required in writing by 6PM of the Monday before the trial. The Trial Secretary is not allowed to change jump heights, preferred vs. regular or move down in classes after closing.

A **PRELIMINARY EMAIL CONFIRMATION** will be sent when the entry is received and processed. Make sure to check the confirmations carefully and notify the Trial Secretary if you have corrections or changes before the closing date.

Jump Height Information

Please check the box on the entry form indicating if you need to have your measured or not, so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the "Dogs To Be Measured List". It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. **All Days there will be No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

Classes Offered:

See the chart above for classes offered each day. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC website (www.akc.org). It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct classes.

Volunteers:

We appreciate everyone who is willing to volunteer at the trial! Please sign up on the white board by the entrance to the ballfield.

Move-ups:

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by 6:00 PM PDT on Monday, May 31, 2021. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to ginnypartridges@gmail.com. No phone move-ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the last class of the day.

Refunds:

A complete refund will be given, for any reason, if received before the closing date and time. After closing, a refund, less \$5/run, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary by start of the trial.

Class Change Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend –Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO) AND FIX AND GO ON:

As of January 1, 2021, For Exhibition only (FEO) and Fix and Go On are permanent parts of the AKC Agility program.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Fix and Go On

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

ENTRY OF INELIGIBLE "A" DOG

A dog which has been entered in an "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions of the dog or handler, may be moved to the "B" class at the same level under the following conditions: 1)The request must state the reason and justification for the move from an "A" class to the "B" class within the level. 2)The request must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least thirty minutes prior to the start of each trial.

Section 27. Training and Handling in the Ring. When a handler is using excessive verbal commands, this could indicate the dog is not under control and is not working with the handler willingly. The judge must determine if this dog should be released for a lack of control. The handler is not allowed to correct or discipline a dog and will be released from the ring.

When the dog's performance does not meet the handler's expectation, the handler may choose to use a "Fix n' Go" option once, which allows the exhibitor to immediately reattempt a single individual exercise. This allows the team to reattempt that one exercise, and then leave the ring. In a two-part exercise, the handler may choose only one part to reattempt. It is the handler's responsibility to tell the judge they are choosing to "Fix n' Go." Using the Fix n' Go option will result in a non-qualifying score (NQ). The handler may begin the reattempt from the start or at any point during the exercise. The judge will call the orders for the reattempted exercise as normal. If a jump needs to be reset, it will be set to the original height.

The handler may choose to help the dog through the Fix n' Go exercise. Helping the dog may be accomplished using verbal encouragement, including additional commands and praise, and/or approaching the dog in a friendly/positive manner without touching the dog.

Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections will not be tolerated. If there is any determination of harshness by the judge, the handler will be immediately released from the ring.
Spectators form their opinion of the sport through seeing the action of the handler and the dog. Care must be taken to avoid any action that might reflect poorly on the sport
