**Indoors on dirt**

**I-5 North/South:** Take Exit #39 (Allen St) West to 1<sup>st</sup>. Turn left on 1<sup>st</sup>, right on Washington, left on 7<sup>th</sup> and take the entrance just south of the agility building. For detailed directions enter Cowlitz Event Center into your navigation app and follow those directions.

**Opening/Closing:** Opened 3/1/23, closed 4/19/23

**Walkthroughs:** There will be a single walk-thru for each class. This is a one judge show, so there won't be conflicts between agility rings. If you have other conflicts with other DCA events, or have questions / concerns, please come to the score table for help.

Directions: Get on I-5 South in Kelso from Allen St. Continue on I-5 S to Vancouver and stay right to take I-205 South. Take Exit 32 from I-205 South. Continue on NE Padden Pkwy. Take NE 62<sup>nd</sup> Ave to NE 84<sup>th</sup> St

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations

**Moveups:** Move-ups will be accepted in writing by the Trial Secretary until 6 PM PDT on Monday, May 1. Move ups for the Thursday trial will be permitted on Wednesday, May 3, 2023 up to 30 minutes following the end of the Wednesday trial. Move ups for the Friday trial will be permitted on Thursday, May 4, 2023 up to 30 minutes following the end of the Thursday trial.

**Crating:** You may crate out of your car, or in the arena. The horse stalls are off-limits.

**Food:** A coffee stand and a food truck will be on-site for competitors' food and beverage needs. There are several fastfood locations nearby, as well as grocery stores.

**Workers:** You will receive a food voucher for each class you work. You may exchange them at the food truck to help offset the cost of your lunch. In addition, each day, we will raffle off one \$25 VISA gift card. Tickets for the gift card raffle will be self-serve. Check the top of the volunteer job whiteboard for the number of tickets for your job/class.

- Measuring:** A volunteer measuring official may be on site. Check with the score table for more info.
- Photos:** We will have a performance backdrop for title photos, candid, placements, and all around fun!!
- “Whiner” raffle:** If your dog NQs on a run, submit a ‘Whiner’ raffle ticket for each non-qualifying run. One winner each day will take home either a bottle of wine, or a bottle of sparkling cider – winner’s choice.
- Masseuse:** **Dog and People: Michele Rockwell** will have her **Dog Show Massage** booth at the 2023 DCA National Specialty starting Wednesday, 5/3 - 5/7. She has been a Canine Rehab therapist for over 20 years and a Medical/Sports Massage therapist for people for 30+ years. Michele’s experience also includes the USA Olympic Sports Massage team and teaching massage therapy for over 20 years. She has over 3,000 clients in 5 states.

- Remind:** We will be using the Remind app to keep everyone posted on the status of the agility ring. To join, go to this webpage --- <https://www.remind.com/join/dcaagility> --- sign up, and select Parent as the role when you are asked for your role.
- Prizes:** Available to everyone, each trial day, with a qualifying score(s) – Q ribbons, new agility title ribbons, and double Q ribbons for qualifying in Master Std and Master JWW at the same trial. Rosettes and Q ribbons are self-serve. Rosettes for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place, except for T2B and T2B preferred. For T2B and T2B Preferred, only a 1<sup>st</sup> place rosette will be awarded.
- Friday only – Dalmatian exhibitors will need to pick up their Q sticker, and then present the sticker to the trophy chair to receive your trophy. Trophies will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> places in the Regular Agility Standard Classes and Regular Agility Jumpers with Weaves Classes. Trophies are awarded for 1st place only in the remainder of the classes.

Judges are not allowed to send the secretary maps until after midnight. Every effort will be made to post the maps by 7:30 am. Maps will be posted in the arena.

**Gate Check-in:** We will have a normal gate steward with a paper gate sheet and may be using an electronic gate checking and monitoring system available by any internet enabled device with a web browser.

The system allows you to check-in, mark conflict or absent, see progress, and live scores as they are entered into the computer. Please check the status to make sure your runs are correct.

Maps will also be available on the same page sometime after 7:30 AM.

**Results:** Results will be posted in the arena and will be available on the same web page as the running order. Q stickers will be available for pickup.
