ENTRY INFORMATION: One entry form per dog may be used for all days, except for mixed entries which need separate entry forms.

Entry Fee: \$20.00 first entry each trial and \$15.00 2^{nd,} 3rd,4th, & 5th regular entry, same dog, same day (includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee per run, per dog/day).

Dogs eligible to enter: This Trial is open to all dogs15 months or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained ILP/PAL numbers or listed in the AKC Canine Partners program or approved FSS breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. AKC Canine Partners must provide their listing number on the entry blank and designate breed as "All American".

Catalog: \$20.00 Please pre-order catalogs using the check box on entry form. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the show.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and ribbons for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular Classes First Place: Blue Second Place: Red Third Place: Yellow Fourth Place: White Qualifying Score: Dark Green

New title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

A MACH / PAX / PACH Ribbon and Jump Bar will be given for any new MACH / PAX / PACH dog! Please let me know before the trial if you are close.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, Oct. 7thth, 2024.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to: <u>sunbums1733@gmail.com</u> No phone move-ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

The regulations now allow exhibitors who have entered a class for which they or their dog is not eligible, to change their entry to a class for which they are eligible. The request for such a change must be in writing and must be submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT MOVEUPS CAN BE DONE AT THE LAST MINUTE! It does mean that if you have previously moved up and then learn your dog has not met the requirements for moving up, you may move back to the correct class, or if you entered Novice A and dog or handler is not eligible, you may move to Novice B. If you have questions. DON'T GUESS – PLEASE ASK

REFUNDS: A refund of entry fees will be given for any bitch that comes into season after the close of entries, provided that the trial secretary is notified before the commencement of judging each day. Except for the above, there shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. **Bitches in season are not allowed in the Agility Trial area.**

<u>CLASSES OFFERED:</u> All levels of Standard, Jumpers, (Fri, Sat, Sun) and FAST (Sat, Sun), including the Preferred Classes will be offered. T2B will be offered Friday & Sunday. Premier Standard & JWW will be offered Saturday. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. <u>The Trial</u> <u>Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).</u>

JUDGES SCHEDULE: Two rings 100'x100' Outdoors on grass.

Friday rings will alternate. Saturday and Sunday 2 rings will run concurrently.

<u>JUDGING:</u> Start time no earlier than 8:30 AM on Friday, and 8:00AM on both Saturday and Sunday, depending on number of entries. Judge's briefing and course walk-through will take place prior to those times. Split walk-throughs for Excellent/Masters level. FAST courses will be nested, with one walk-through. They may be judged together.

Anticipated Order of Classes (any changes will be published in the Judging Program)

- Friday: Ring 1 T2B, Standard (Exc/Master, Open, Novice) Alternate with Ring 2
 - Ring 2 JWW (Exc/Master, Open, Novice) Alternate with Ring 1
- Saturday: Ring 1 Standard (Premier, Exc/Mas, Open, Novice)

Ring 2 - FAST (all levels) JWW (Novice, Open, Exc/Mas, Premier)

Sunday: Ring 1 – T2B, Standard (Exc/Mas, Open, Novice)

Ring 2 - FAST (all levels) JWW (Novice, Open, Exc/Mas)

Friday and Sunday will be small to tall dogs. Saturday will be tall to small.

<u>JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION</u>: There is a section at top of entry form to designate if your dog has a valid height card or if it needs to be measured. <u>Please arrive early to the trials if your dog(s) needs to be measured</u>. Marianne Diehl will measure on Friday for temporary height cards. Lori Sage is a VMO and will be available Saturday and Sunday to measure. ALL dogs competing in agility must possess an official AKC Jump Height Card, permanent or temporary. See Chapter 2, Section 5 of the Regulations for Agility Trials Handbook for rules.

Check your entry forms and confirmations.

A preliminary email confirmation will be sent when the entry is received and processed. Make sure to check those confirmations closely and notify the trial secretary if you have corrections or changes before the closing date. AKC prohibits modification of an entry after the closing date/time, except for move ups made in writing by specified deadline.

Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

<u>OBSTACLES</u>: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Equipment is provided by Jim and Laurie Clark.

CRATING INFORMATION:

There is ample space for crating around the rings. There is very limited shade, so plan accordingly.

VOLUNTEERS

We are using the white board signup at the trial for volunteers. If you can help out in a class, please sign up in the morning or check with the chief ring steward. Thank you to everybody that helps!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms, <u>or without the agreement attached, are not acceptable</u>.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least five days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Wenatchee Kennel Club** assumes **NO** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs <u>must be on leash</u> except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. (State Park regulations.)

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

FOOD INFORMATION

There are fast food locations and grocery stores in Wenatchee within a few blocks of the show site.

Driving Directions to Confluence State Park, 333 Olds Station Rd., Wenatchee, WA 98801

From West Hwy 97 and 2: Take the 2nd exit in the traffic circle onto Easy St. Turn left onto Penny Rd. Turn right onto Chester Kimm Rd, then turn left onto Olds Station Rd. Turn right to stay on Olds Station Rd to the entrance of the State Park.

From East Hwy 97 and 2: Take the US-97 Alt N exit toward Entiat/Chelan (follow State Park Signs). Turn left onto Euclid Ave. Turn left to stay on Euclid. Turn right onto Isenhart Ave. Turn right onto Olds Station Rd and to the State Park signs and entrance.

PARKING & ACCOMODATIONS

NOTE: There are several events taking place in Wenatchee this weekend, so make lodging arrangements early!

PARKING: A Discover Pass is required to park at Confluence State Park. Passes cost \$10 for one day or \$30 for an Annual Pass, which is valid at all Washington State Parks for 12 months from date of purchase. Passes are available at the park entrance during business hours and from State Park offices.

CAMPING: Camping may be accommodated at two locations. **1)** RV (dry) camping is available adjacent the group parking area near the rings at a cost of \$25 per night (parks may alter cost Oct 1st). Trial Staff will collect these fees. <u>The camping fee covers the daily Discover Pass requirement.</u> **2)** Camping is also available at designated Park campsites, some of which have hookups. AGAIN, this year: Reservations for at least part of the campsites at Confluence Park may be made in advance. For information, check out <u>www.parks.wa.gov</u> or call 888-226-7688.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. <u>The Double Q still requires that Standard</u> Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights (in different classes) within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. (EXAMPLE: if you are entering a dog in some Regular classes and some Preferred classes submit one entry form for the Regular classes, and another entry form for the Preferred classes).

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of one obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. <u>Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.</u>

For Exhibition Only (FEO) Effective July 1, 2024

At the option of the club, a handler may choose to change <u>any class entry</u> into a For Exhibition Only (FEO) run. The handler must notify the scribe and the judge as they enter the ring prior to the start of the run that they are doing an FEO run. The scribe sheet shall be marked "FEO", no time "NT", and "E" for an excused, non-qualifying run. <u>Maximum Courses</u> <u>Time for FEO shall be 45 seconds for all classes, except for FAST which will use the set FAST course times.</u>

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form: the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level- Novice, Open, Excellent, Master. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Toys are allowed in the ring.
 - > Toys must be non-audible
 - > Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - > Toys that roll freely cannot be used.

- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry.
