Travel 0.1 mi and the facility is on the left.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRY INFORMATION: One entry form may be used for all days. Use separate entry if mixing preferred and regular Entry Fee: $$35 - 1^{st}$, $$30 - 2^{nd}$, $$25 - 3^{rd}$, $$20 - 4^{th}$, $$20 - 5^{th}$ entry per dog / per day.

"The LRC Inc. is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 110, Paper entries: 240. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

1) include postage or be metered;

2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required"

AWARDS: Rosette Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

w Fourth Place: White Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

Unless otherwise listed, all trophies will be Pewtarex and offered by the Labrador Retriever Club, Inc. Qualifying scores are require for all prizes.

First Place in each class.....Rosette & LRC Medallion Second through Fourth in each classRosette & Dog Toy

All dogs earning a MACH or PACH will receive a commemorative rosette and bar. Please let the trial CHAIR know if you are close to one of these titles.

High in Trial each day.....Silver Service Plate

HIT will be based on the highest score from the Excellent/Master Jww and Excellent/Master Std courses combined (clean rounds only). Score = StdCourseTime-dog'sTime. Preferred dogs will be using the SCT from their regular jump heights.

Check your entry forms and confirmations:

Please be aware that AKC rules prohibit modification of an entry after the closing date/time. The ONLY allowed changes are for "moveups" in class and those are required in writing by 6PM of the Monday before the trial. The trial secretary is not allowed to change jump heights, preferred vs. regular, or move down in classes after closing.

A preliminary email confirmation will be sent when the entry is received and processed. Make sure to check those confirmations closely and notify the trial secretary if you have corrections or changes before the closing date.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all Labrador Retrievers fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in ay way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in the regulations, it includes both sexes.

HEIGHT DIVISION The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judges only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial who do not possess an official height card.

<u>OBSTACLES</u>: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. <u>*All Days*</u> there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

<u>CLASSES OFFERED</u>: See the chart above for offered classes each day. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the "Dogs To Be Measured List". <u>It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.</u>"

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. The club may cancel these events in extreme weather conditions.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The clubs have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required. If dogs are not checked in before the end of their jump height walk through, dog & handler team bay be marked absent. Failure to be at ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.

Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior handlers must enter their JH# and complete the junior handler portion of the form. **Include only AKC Titles on the form.**

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, without the agreement attached are not acceptable.

Returned checks do NOT constitute a valid entry. There is a \$10 returned check fee payable to the club.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the email address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The Clubs assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. The Clubs do not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth in the Official AKC Entry form for this event.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested with the clubs, or persons to whom the assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the clubs. Photographs and/or video recordings taken for any reason other than personal use are strictly prohibited.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. Dogs under 4 mos old are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

No solicitation permitted at the show site.

Electronic timing will be used.

No un-entered dogs are permitted within 30' of the ring barriers.

No laser lights to be used withing 150' of the ring.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday. Sept 25** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are

6:00 PM PDT on Monday, Sept 25. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to <u>r2agility@gmail.com</u>. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the last class of each day.

REFUNDS: A complete refund will be given, for any reason, if received before the closing date and time. After closing, a refund of entry fees less \$5/run will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary by the start of the day. A refund of all but \$10.00 per day for injured or ill dogs. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.

No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$12.

No checks will be returned if an entry is cancelled. Checks will be shredded.





In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
