If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly. No hand deliveries will be accepted in the first twenty-four hours following the opening date and time.

Refunds

A full refund of entry fees will be given for any bitch that comes into season, and a refund of entry fees, less \$5.00 per run, will be given for any dog or handler that is injured or ill, if written notification is provided to the Trial Secretary prior to the beginning of judging for the day. **Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds.**

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC limited registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or AKC Canine partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners are eligible to participate, provided that their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Please designate the dog's breed as "All American Dog" on the entry form.

Important Information for Exhibitors -- PLEASE READ!

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, fax, e-mail or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form, are not acceptable. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Entering Regular & Preferred Jump Heights

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights [in different classes] within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day. A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. [EXAMPLE: if you are entering a dog in some Regular classes and some Preferred classes, submit one entry form for the Regular classes, and another entry form for the Preferred classes.] When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Measuring and Jump Height Card Information

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

On the entry form, please designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the

Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during the day of show check-in. However, it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.

<u>Our judge is not a Volunteer Measuring Official</u>. Dogs under 2 years of age with an official temporary measurement, dogs with a permanent height card, and dogs that have had at least one official measurement after age 2 by a VMO or AKC agility representative do not need to be measured. All other dogs MUST be measured by one of the judges prior to running; this measurement only applies to this weekend's trials and does not count toward the dog's permanent height card.

Move Ups

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted in writing (e-mail OK) so that the Trial Secretary receives them by 6:00PM PST on Monday June 30, 2025. Reply to your confirmation and include the class you are moving from/to. Email to neeleammon@gmail.com. If you do not receive an acknowledgement of your move-up request, please contact the Trial Secretary to make sure that it was received. No phone move ups accepted.

Saturday to Sunday move-ups will be accepted at the trial; they must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial is concluded each day.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying. FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show. Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed. Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed. The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge. Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

Toys are allowed in the ring, food/treats are not allowed in the ring.

- Toys must be non-audible
- Toys may not leave the handler's hand
- Toys that roll freely cannot be used

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Obstacles

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular Classes

First Place: Blue Third Place: Yellow Second Place: Red Fourth Place: White Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

All dogs completing a MACH or PACH at this trial will receive a MACH/PACH bar and ribbon. Please let us know before the trial if you are close.

Trial Location

These Agility Trials will be held outdoors on grass at the SDTC club property, ring size is 100' x 90'. The property is adjacent to an active railroad track. We will try to make accommodation for runs negatively affected by the passing trains. It will be the judge's discretion on those runs. The ring will be fenced, with entry/exit openings. This leaves no room for personal pop-ups to be placed outside. There will be crating available indoors in our air conditioned building. Please bring a mat to place under your crate or x-pen. X-pens with a mat under them will be allowed only for multiple dogs, otherwise crates only. You may be asked to condense your space if needed. There is no grass area for exercising dogs, only graveled area. Outside the property's fenced area is a weedy area – PLEASE be aware that there are weeds with stickers. And of course, we know you will uphold the great reputation of agility exhibitors by cleaning up after your dogs! Set-up time for the trial will be in an e-mail prior to the trial.


Volunteers
