Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRY INFORMATION: One entry form may be used for all days

Entry Fee: \$35.00 for the 1st, \$30.00 for the 2nd and \$25.00 for the 3rd-5th entry per dog, per day. These include the required AKC fees of \$4.50 / run per dog/day.

Catalog: \$10.00 Please pre-order catalogs using entry form. A limited number will be available at the show.

ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

"LRC is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 110, Paper entries: 240. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

1) include postage or be metered; 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender. 3) **Express mail must be designated "no signature required"**

PRIZES and AWARDS:

Unless otherwise noted, all prizes and awards are given by the Labrador Retriever Club, Inc. Rosettes will be awarded in all classes. Rosettes will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular Classes First Place: Blue Second Place: Red Third Place: Yellow Fourth Place: White Qualifying Score: Dark Green
New Titles: Red/White/Blue Rosettes. A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

MACH/PACH bars and Ribbons: A MACH/PACH bar and rosette will be awarded to all dogs that inform the trial secretary of the title possibility by closing. Help us make sure we have enough fancy ribbons on hand to help you celebrate the big event !

National Agility Trial #1 - Wednesday: 1st place will receive a newly designed medallion for the 250th celebration and rosette
Regional Agility Trial #2 - Thursday: 1st place will receive a Waterdog Gear Lead and rosette

High in Trial Regular and High in Trial Preferred each day will receive \$250 and a rosette. The High in Trial awards will be determined by highest score in regular classes standard and jumpers with ties broken by fastest time defined in yards per second as calculated by dividing course length (in yards as determined by the judge) by the dog's time (in seconds). If a tie should still exist, the award will go to the dog from the highest level class.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Wednesday, Sept. 23**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to r2agility@gmail.com. No phone move ups accepted. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

REFUNDS: A refund of entry fees, less \$5/run, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first class.

JUDGING SCHEDULE:

Indoors on dirt. 2 Rings 100 wide x 90 deep.

Start Times no earlier than 8:00 AM each day for first dog on the line. Measuring and walkthroughs before that time.

Fast will be run as a combined class, one course for all levels with unique sends for each level

Thu (small to tall): Ring 1: Exc Std, Fast, Opn Std, Nov Std
Ring 2: Prm Jww, Exc Jww, T2B, Opn Jww, Nov Jww

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all Labrador Retrievers only, fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judges only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial that do not possess an official height card.

8 inches	for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
12 inches	for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 inches	for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20 inches	for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 inches	for dogs over 22 inches at the withers
24 Choice	Only for dogs 22" and under at owners' discretion

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. All Days there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

CLASSES OFFERED: See the chart above for offered classes each day. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the **American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390**, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please indicate if your dog needs to be measured on the entry form.

Check your entry forms and confirmations:

Please be aware that AKC rules prohibit modification of an entry after the closing date/time. The **ONLY** allowed changes are for "move-ups" in class and those are required in writing by 6PM of the previous Wednesday before a trial that starts on Wednesday. The trial secretary is not allowed to change jump heights or classes after closing.

A preliminary email confirmation will be sent when the entry is received and processed. Make sure to check those confirmations closely and notify the trial secretary if you have corrections or changes before the closing date.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. We will NOT wait for exhibitors, except for pre-arranged changes due to conflict. **Entry Confirmations and approximate check-in times will be sent to the address or email address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show**, contact the Trial Secretary. Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a stamped, self-addressed postcard with entry.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Labrador Retriever Club, Inc.** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

CRATING INFORMATION: Crating will be available outside the rings around the arena in designated areas.

Food Information: Food trucks will be provided.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

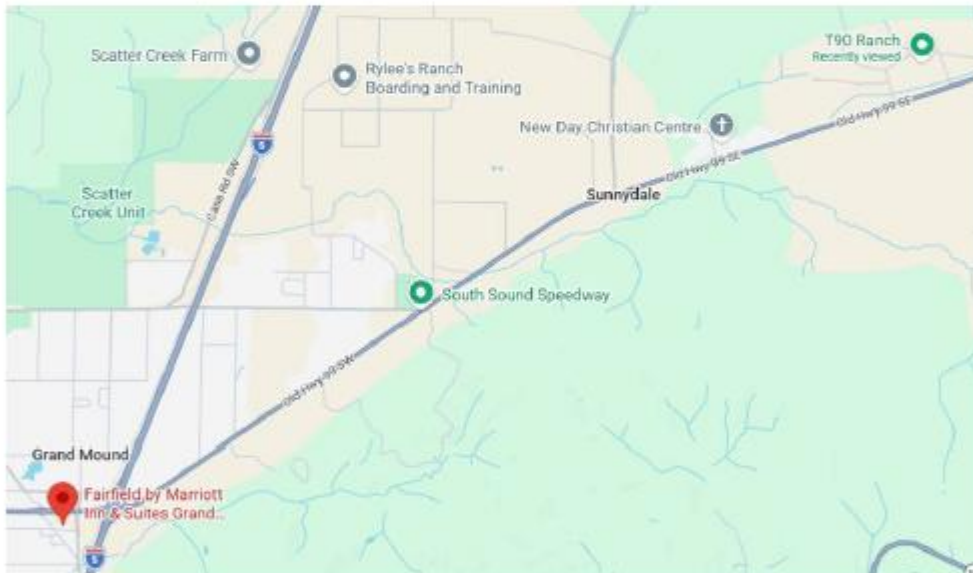
From I-5 SOUTHbound take exit 88. Turn LEFT from the exit ramp and go ~6.9 and T90 Ranch will be on the left side of the road.

From I-5 NORTHbound take exit 88. Turn RIGHT from the exit ramp and go ~6.8 miles and T90 Ranch will be on the left side of the road.

From the HOST HOTEL (without Starbucks) exit out the back of the parking lot and turn right onto Sargent RD. At the traffic circle turn right onto Hwy 12. Continue on Hwy 12 for ~ 7 miles and T90 Ranch will be on your left.

From the HOST HOTEL (with Starbucks) turn right out of the Starbucks lot and head to the roundabout. Go round the roundabout to make a u-turn and get into the right hand turn lane to turn right onto Hwy 12. Go ~7.1 miles to T90 Ranch which will be on the left.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
