**ATTENTION: EXHIBITORS STAYING IN LOCAL HOTELS
HOTEL POLICIES**

We do not have a large quantity of hotel rooms in this area. Therefore, maintaining a good relationship with those that will accept dogs is CRITICAL to YOU, our exhibitors. To help ensure that we have hotels that will accept dogs in the future, the following policies are now in effect and will be strictly enforced. Violation of these policies may result in a HRKC/AKC Bench Hearing.

IF YOU PLAN TO STAY IN A HOTEL AND TAKE YOUR DOG INTO THE ROOM:

- Contact the Hotel DIRECTLY to make your reservation. Indicate you require a “dog room” – DO NOT use a third party reservation service.
- ABSOLUTELY NO BATHING OF DOGS is allowed in ANY of the guest rooms, guest room bathrooms or bathtubs
- Dogs MUST be on a leash in public areas of the hotel at all times.
- Dogs MUST be exercised in the designated dog area.
- You MUST pick up after your dog! DO NOT allow your dog to urinate on buildings, garbage cans, etc.
- NO DOGS are to be left UNATTENDED in guest rooms at ANY TIME!
- No dogs are allowed IN or ON beds.
- Dogs that are excessively barking must be removed from the premises in respect for the other guests in the hotel.
- Do NOT take dogs into non-dog- allotted rooms. This creates problems for persons with allergies and requires special post-dog cleaning.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraphy entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry Fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least five days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The Hurricane Ridge Kennel Club, City of Sequim, and MJS Consulting assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up areas.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

ONLINE VS PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

To enter online, go to the R2AgilityOnline home page.. Follow the instructions there to complete your entry for this event online. For the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries is designated as follows: 100 online entries, 200 paper entries. After the first 48 hours, if either form of entry (online or paper) has not filled, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of opening date & time must include postage or be metered; Must be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

Express mail must be designated “no signature required”.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:

The trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Check your entry forms and confirmations.

Please be aware that AKC rules prohibit modification of an entry after the closing date/time. The **ONLY** allowed changes are for “move-ups” in class and those are required in writing by **6PM of the Monday before the trial**. The Trial Secretary is not allowed to change jump heights, preferred vs. regular or move down in classes after closing.

A **PRELIMINARY EMAIL CONFIRMATION** will be sent when the entry is received and processed. Make sure to check the confirmations carefully and notify the Trial Secretary if you have corrections or changes before the closing date.

Prizes and Award Information

- First Prize – Blue Flat Ribbon *** Second Prize – Red Flat Ribbon
- Third Prize – Yellow Flat Ribbon *** Fourth Prize – White Flat Ribbon
- Qualifying Score – Dark Green Rosette
- A Title Ribbon will be awarded to each dog completing a Standard and/or JWW title at these shows.
- Rosette offered for each dog obtaining a double Q at these trials.
- If a MACH, PACH, or AGCH title is completed at these shows, a Rosette and Jump bar will be awarded. A New Title rosette will be awarded for PAX.

*A qualifying score is required for all prizes
All awards must be claimed at the show*

Jump Height Information

Please check the box on the entry form indicating if you need to have your dog measured or not, so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the "Dogs To Be Measured List". It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. ***All Days* there will be No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

Classes Offered:

See the chart above for classes offered each day. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the **American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390**, or from the AKC website (www.akc.org). It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct classes.

Move-ups:

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by 6:00 PM PDT on **Monday, May 25th, 2026**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to agilgolden@comcast.net. No phone move-ups accepted. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the last class of the day.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Refunds:

A complete refund will be given, for any reason, if received before the closing date and time. After closing, a refund, less \$5 per run, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary by start of the trial.
